Importance of Wireless in IT Strategy

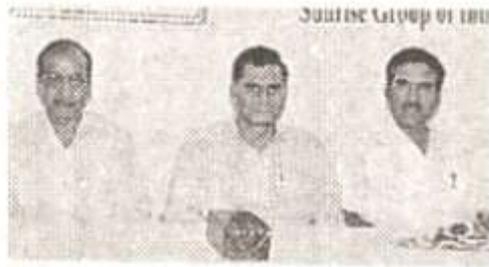
